## About Our Seedlings

The varieties we sell are the same ones we use, and have tested, in our field.

We start with the best seeds we can get and plant them in an organically certified, compost-based potting soil from Vermont Compost Company.

We love our seedlings. You will too.

**Pre-orders must be post-marked by Saturday, March 4 and are only available to Friends of the Farm. Not a friend? Join on this order form.**

**Minimum order is \$20**

All of our seedlings are hardened off. Most are ready for planting in your garden upon pick-up.

## Pricing and Selection

All of our Early Spring Seedling Sale plants are grown and sold in 6-packs (\$5/pack). However, you do *not* have to buy 6 of any variety. You can mix and match as much as you want. Just remember that when you tally your order at the end of the form you must round up to the nearest full 6-pack so you might as well fill them all, and buy a multiple of 6. For example, you could buy 2 lettuce, 2 kale, and 1 cabbage for a total of 5 plants, but you'd still be charged for a full 6-pack (\$5), so why not add one more plant? As you fill out the order form please put the number of *individual plants* you want of each variety in the column on the right. At the end of the form you'll total how many plants you've ordered and divide by 6 to come up with the number of 6-packs you're buying. Remember, you're *always rounding up* so you might as well fill all those packs
